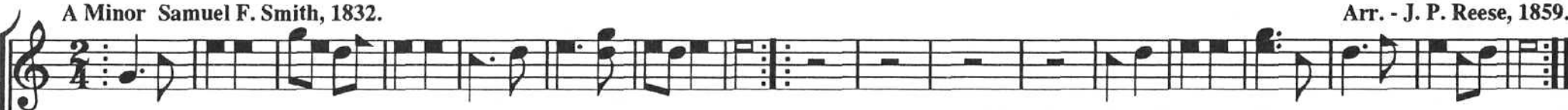


# CAN I LEAVE YOU? 8,7,8,7,4,7.
